Wear no forced air of solemnity or sorrow.

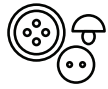
Laugh as we always laughed at the little jokes we enjoyed together.

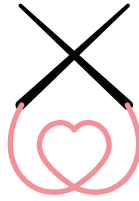
