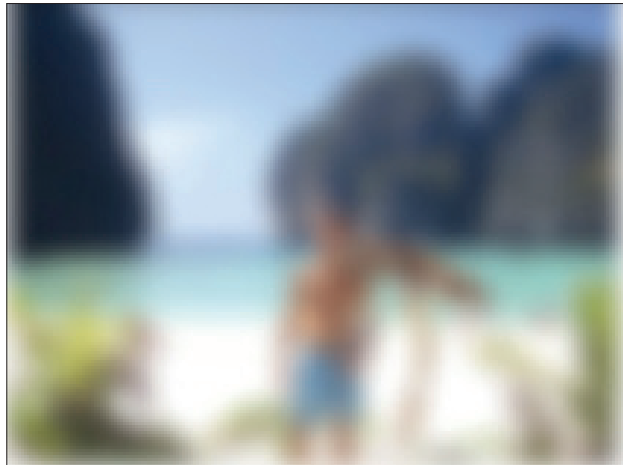
### Entrance Music

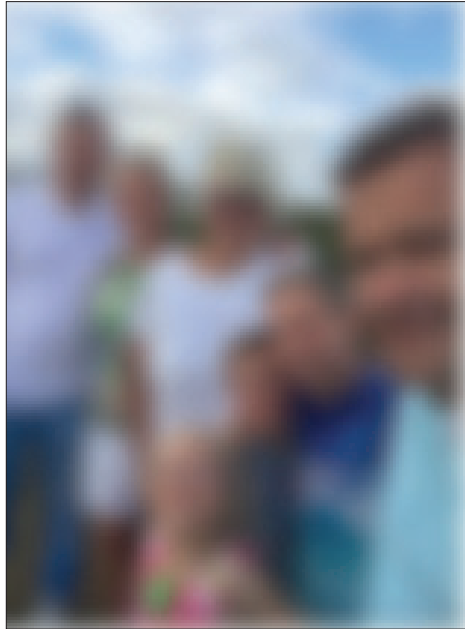
