 And my cup overflows.

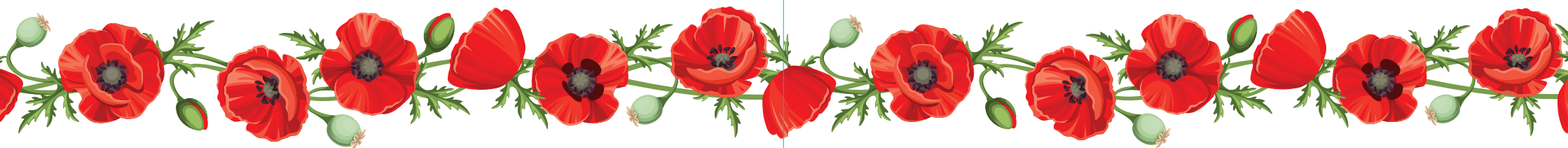
Goodness and mercy all my life
